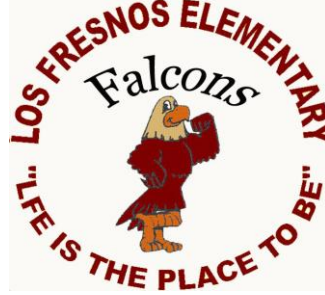

### Mission Statement

### THE PARENTS' AGREEMENT

#### As a parent, I commit to:

1. Ensure my child attends school daily, prepared, well rested and arrives on time with school supplies.
2. Have high expectations for my child as an individual.
3. Provide my child with a quiet area to complete his/her school work.
4. Support the teacher and assist my child as needed to ensure the completion of all homework assignments.
5. Attend parent/teacher conferences as needed.
6. Ensure my child respects all school property and property of others.
7. Monitor the amount of time my child spends watching television/ playing video games, electronic devices and supervise the quality of content.
8. Check and sign my child's academic progress regularly (i.e. HAC, remind 101, progress reports, Class Dojo, communication through student homework folders and behavior chart).
9. Teach my child to respect his/her teachers, school personnel, and peers.
10. Encourage my child to adhere to campus safety rules, regulations and dress code.

#### We encourage you to be involved parents in the following activities:

1. Attend educational sessions for parents.
2. Attend school events/activities such as: honor assemblies, field days, programs, musical activities, and open houses.
3. Volunteer in my child's school after volunteer clearance by district.
4. Attend meetings sponsored by parent-teacher organizations (PTO).
5. Assist with other school-related activities.
6. Have lunch with my child at his or her school at least once a year.
7. Involve and participate in different existing district parent committees.
8. In case of an emergency, keep teacher and office informed of any phone number and/ or address changes.

## **THE TEACHER'S AGREEMENT**

**As a teacher, I commit to:**

1. Maintain and enforce high expectations.
2. Provide a safe and secure educational environment where your child will become responsible for his/her behavior and education.
3. Follow the curriculum standards set by the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills.
4. Help your child to follow campus, classroom, and bus rules.
5. Acknowledge and respect each student's individuality.
6. Assign homework and record daily grades.
7. Keep you informed of your child's academic progress and attendance through HAC, remind 101/ class dojo progress reports, communication through student folders and behavior chart.
8. Assist you in providing helpful tips to help your child at home.
9. Attend school functions and activities.
10. Schedule Parent-Teacher conferences as necessary.
11. Assist the students when necessary.
12. Come to school on time and well prepared to teach my students.
13. Attend professional development to stay current on education practices.
14. Making contact with parent regarding attendance.

**As a student, I commit to:**      **THE STUDENT'S AGREEMENT**

1. Have high expectations for myself.
2. Attend school daily, prepared, well rested and on time with my school supplies.
3. Finish all class work.
4. Return all assignments completed.
5. Ask for assistance when needed.
6. Follow classroom, campus, dress code and bus rules.
7. Practice universally accepted behaviors such as: honesty, integrity, courtesy, justice, responsibility and respect for students, teachers and all adult staff.
8. Protect school property and respect the property of others.
9. Communicate my academic progress to my parents through my daily student folder/ homework folder.
10. Watch quality educational programs on television and electronic devices.
11. Give all notes from teacher/campus to parents, and return signed, if required.
12. Represent my school with high standards at all school sponsored events.
